

TRIP TO COBURG

Saturday, 9th September 2017

Our day-trip to Coburg and the area will now take place on Saturday, 9th September. The following plan may be subject to slight changes, but we shall send you a final plan by roundmail in mid-August.

- 8:30 a.m.** Depart Erlangen by bus from Turnerbund
- 9:30 a.m.** Arrival in Coburg
- 10:00 a.m.** Guided tour of Ehrenburg Castle, the residence of the ruling dukes of Coburg
- 11:30 a.m.** Short guided tour of Coburg
- 12:30 p.m.** Lunch in one of Coburg's many traditional restaurants
- 1:45 p.m.** Depart for Rödentel and a visit with guided tour of Castle Rosenau, birth place of Prince Albert and favourite place of Queen Victoria on her summer visits to Coburg.
Here you might choose to visit the Museum of Modern Glass or take a stroll in the beautiful grounds of the castle.
- 5:00 p.m.** Depart for the medieval town of Seßlach, with a short guided walking tour before an evening meal in one of the town's traditional restaurants.
- 8:00 p.m.** Depart for Erlangen, return ca. 9 p.m.

The price will depend on the number of participants but will be somewhere in the region of €35-€40. The price includes bus transport and guided tours (in English and German, whenever possible).
