

The German Carnival Museum

The best time to visit the German Carnival Museum in Kitzingen is during the Fasching season, so on March 8th we set off for this historic wine town in Lower Franconia to amuse ourselves in Germany's largest museum devoted to all things relating to Carnival, or Fasching as we call it in Erlangen. Those who know about such matters are aware that carnival traditions vary enormously from one corner of Germany (and beyond) to another and the Kitzingen museum does a great job in presenting and explaining these different regional traditions.

Afterwards we went for a stroll along the Main, before driving on to Hüttenheim, a picturesque village with a large fortified church, one of the best preserved in Franconia. It is somewhat similar to Mönchsondheim, another "Kirchenburg" which we are planning to visit in 2018.
